Holy Family - instant rice, powdered coffee creamer; beef bouillon, canned or powdered milk and **juice boxes** and margarine for the House of Nazareth.

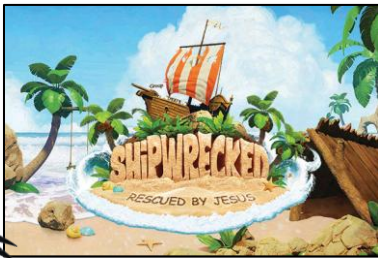


"Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have; God is pleased by sacrifices of that kind." Hebrews 13:16
