

**SOCIAL ACTION COMMITTEE**

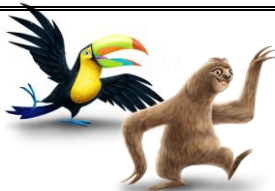

During our week of Vacation Bible School, the children and their families donated

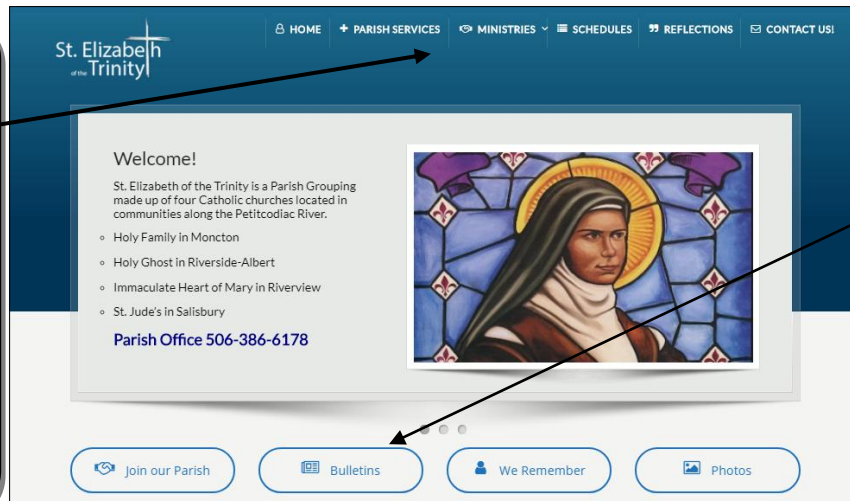
**325 lbs of food** to the Albert County Food Bank. **Nicely done!!**

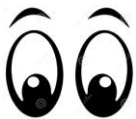
