The St. Elizabeth of the Trinity parish grouping acknowledges that we carry out our worship and ministry on the traditional *unceded* territory of the Mi'kmaq and Wəlastəkwiyyik (Maliseet) Peoples. This territory is covered by the "Treaties of Peace and Friendship" which these nations first signed with the British Crown in 1726. The treaties did not deal with surrender of lands and resources but, in fact, recognized Mi'kmaq and Wəlastəkwiyyik title and established the rules for what was to be an ongoing relationship between nations.




**Food Banks**

### Delegation to the Holy See



*Many people have expressed their sorrow and disappointment to me following the tragic discovery of the remains of many children at former Residential School sites in Western Canada. As with many of you, the pain of such a tragedy has disturbed me and deeply touched me. Since then, many people have rightly called for an explanation and an apology from the Catholic Church.*

*In search of more significant healing and reconciliation for the future, the CCCB (Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops) announced yesterday that a delegation will travel to Rome to meet Pope Francis from 17 to 20 December 2021. Pope Francis will hold personal meetings with each of the three distinct groups of delegates, First Nations, Métis, and Inuit, and a final audience with all representatives on 20 December 2021. Planning for the delegation is underway, and further details will be provided at a later date.*

*These meetings will allow Pope Francis to hear directly from representatives of Indigenous peoples in the hopes of responding to the suffering of Indigenous peoples and the ongoing effects of intergenerational trauma. In the 29 June 2021 statement, the CCCB wrote: " The Bishops of Canada reaffirm their sincere hope that these forthcoming encounters will lead to a shared future of peace and harmony between Indigenous Peoples and the Catholic Church in Canada." I invite you to visit the CCCB website on this subject.*


