The St. Elizabeth of the Trinity parish grouping acknowledges that we carry out our worship and ministry on the traditional *unceded* territory of the Mi'kmaq and Wəlastəkwiyyik (Maliseet) Peoples. This territory is covered by the "Treaties of Peace and Friendship" which these nations first signed with the British Crown in 1726. The treaties did not deal with surrender of lands and resources but, in fact, recognized Mi'kmaq and Wəlastəkwiyyik title and established the rules for what was to be an ongoing relationship between nations.

# *Congratulations!*

During this time of graduations and planning for future endeavours, I want to acknowledge our seminarian, **Carlos Jacinto**, who has crossed an important threshold in his life. On Sunday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, with Bishop Vienneau presiding, Carlos celebrated **The Rite of Admission** (The Rite of Admission to Candidacy for Ordination as Deacon and Priest...there's a mouthful). The Rite of Admission is celebrated when a bishop accepts a seminarian's petition to be admitted as a candidate for ordination. It means Carlos has moved from discernment to decision (although he will be "discerning" for the rest of his life). In other words, Carlos is saying, "I'm going for it," and the bishop, on behalf of us all, is responding, "We support your decision and we bless it." The Rite of Admission is one of a series of minor rites celebrated during a seminarian's journey on the way to the major rite of ordination, first as a deacon, then as a priest. Although Carlos still has two years of formation to complete back in London, Ontario, let us keep him in our prayers. Congratulations, Carlos. Our pride goes out from Holy Family Church, from St. Elizabeth of the Trinity Parish grouping, and from the Archdiocese of Moncton.
