
#### **Food Banks**



#### SEPTEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup> IS WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CARE OF CREATION Prayer for the Season of Creation 2021



On September 1<sup>st</sup>, 1989, His Holiness Dimitrios I, Patriarch of Constantinople, decreed the first day of September as a day of special reverence and prayer for the Safeguarding of Creation. The Orthodox Church continues to celebrate this important day, the start of the liturgical year, with the reading of Chapter 1 of Genesis.

Since 2008, The World Council of Churches has encouraged all Christian denominations to observe and celebrate this day. In 2015, Pope Francis announced that the Catholic Church would also mark September 1st as

the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. It provides an occasion for Christians from various churches around the world to gather together in prayer for the well-being of the earth, our common home.

'This is the season for letting our prayer be inspired anew by closeness to nature ... to reflect on our lifestyles ... for undertaking prophetic actions ... directing the planet towards life, not death." Pope Francis

Once again, Holy Family Church will be collecting **School Supplies** to help the less fortunate and we invite anyone who would like to donate, to do so!


