The treaties did not deal with surrender of lands and resources but, in fact, recognized Mi'kmaq and Wəlastəkwiyik title and established the rules for what was to be an ongoing relationship between nations.

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. I remember as a very young girl, picturing Jesus ascending into the clouds and I naively thought that if I could get above the clouds, I would see Jesus sitting on the right-hand side of God the Father. The first time I flew in an airplane, we were above these beautiful white fluffy clouds and, of course, I didn't see Jesus sitting beside God. However, I did feel a sense of wonder and appreciation of nature and the world God created for us.

It is now up to each of us in our way to carry on the mission and ministry of Jesus. Through us today, the world will know that Jesus is alive, present, and active in the world. As Pope Francis says to each of us, "Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that they have experienced the love of God in Jesus." Jesus, ascending into Heaven, has not left, deserted, or abandoned us. He is with us when we gather to break bread with each other. He is with us when we reach out to help and support each other. These are the signs that Jesus is in us and with us today and forever. We also should reflect on His words (at the end of today's Gospel reading), "And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

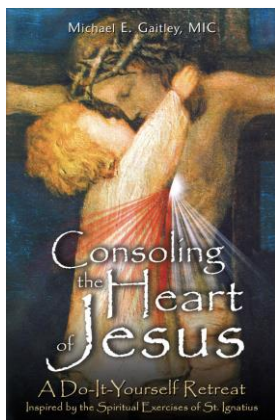

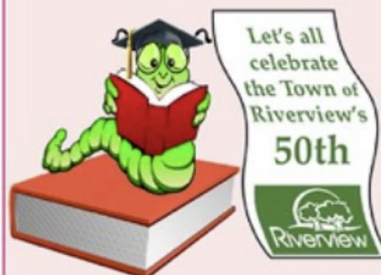
