The St. Elizabeth of the Trinity parish grouping acknowledges that we carry out our worship and ministry on the traditional unceded territory of the Mi'kmaq and Wəlastəkwiyik (Maliseet) Peoples. This territory is covered by the "Treaties of Peace and Friendship" which these nations first signed with the British Crown in 1726. The treaties did not deal with surrender of lands and resources but, in fact, recognized Mi'kmaq and Wəlastəkwiyik title and established the rules for what was to be an ongoing relationship between nations.

Catechism
Registration for ALL YEAR LEVELS
Catechism 2024-25 has begun!

Formal catechism in our St. Elizabeth of the Trinity Parish Grouping has begun for all children who will be six years old before December 31st of this year. We use a



“Parent Coaching Model” where parents/guardians and child come to catechism and sit at a table together. A Coaching Catechist leads the parents through each session so that the parent is, in fact, the Catechist for the child!

Catechism sessions for 2024-25 will begin the week of September 9th.

Catechism sessions are 75-90 minutes in length and take place once every two weeks.

You will accompany your child to each session where you will journey alongside them, as together you grow in faith. (We understand that families lead busy lives. If you are unable to attend with your child, they may be accompanied by another adult, such as a grandparent, an aunt or uncle, or a close family friend.)

Children will be separated into groupings: one grouping for **Years 1, 2 and 3** and another grouping for **Years 4, 5 and 6**. If you have more than one child registered in the same grouping, (for example a child in Year 1 and another in Year 3) you can all attend the same session together!

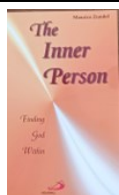
Children in **Year 7** (Confirmation year) will be in their own grouping.

There are two ways to register, and payment is required at time of registration.

Catechism fees are \$30 per child or \$50 per family. You can:

Register online on our website www.setmoncton.com/registration and make payment through e-transfer to the email ihmc.set@gmail.com and indicate **Catechism fees** in the comment box.

Come into the church and register. The office hours are 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. - Monday to Thursday.



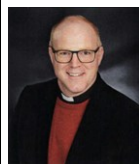

Dear parishioners,

Our Moncton Diocese is organizing through all the Catholic Parishes a special annual COLLECTION, on November 2nd and 3rd 2024 under the banner of REBUILDING ... TOGETHER

We are sending you this message as an introduction-explanation. You'll recall that in his letter to parishes this past may, Mgr. Guy Desrochers explained the Archdiocese of Moncton had narrowly avoided bankruptcy due to the generous donations of several organisations outside our diocese. However, to keep the archdiocese going and rebuild our assets we need your help now to move towards financial recovery. Our 2024 budget forecast calls for a deficit of \$311, 000.00.

The archdiocese offers many services to parishes, liturgy, catechism, pastoral care (chaplains) in hospitals, adult faith education, youth education and summer camps, provides help to parishes and priests, partnerships with parishes on property management, manages insurance and claims provides tribunal and chancellery services and the list goes on. In addition, let us never forget that our Church is always there when you need its services: baptism, confirmation, sacrament of the sick and special visits, funerals and wakes.

Our archdiocese has some full time and part time employees for the needs and services of all. In the last several months we have made great strides towards rebuilding and putting in place the necessary structures to improve the administrative and financial structures which we believe required either straightening, updating or implementing new structures or policies where structures or policies did not exist. To achieve our goals money is required. The financial contribution of the faithful of the diocese is important. Let us be generous so our Church may continue to shine and be strong. As always, we are confident of your positive response... each one according to your means.

We would be grateful if you would share this information with as many people as possible, paying special attention to those who are less regular or distant for all sorts of reasons including your business partners.
