The St. Elizabeth of the Trinity parish grouping acknowledges that we carry out our worship and ministry on the traditional unceded territory of the Mi'kmaq and Wəlastəkwiyik (Maliseet) Peoples. This territory is covered by the "Treaties of Peace and Friendship" which these nations first signed with the British Crown in 1726. The treaties did not deal with surrender of lands and resources but, in fact, recognized Mi'kmaq and Wəlastəkwiyik title and established the rules for what was to be an ongoing relationship between nations.

## CATECHISM REGISTRATION HAS BEGUN!!

Formal catechism at St. Elizabeth of the Trinity Parish Grouping has begun for all children who will be six years old before December 31<sup>st</sup> of this year. We have "Parent Coaching Model" where parents/guardians and child come to catechism and sit at a table together. A Coaching Catechist leads the parents through each session so that the parent is, in fact, the Catechist for the child! Sessions are 75-90 minutes in length and take place once every two weeks.

***Catechism sessions for 2024-25 will begin the week of September 9<sup>th</sup>. Registration is required.***

There are two ways to register, and payment is required at time of registration.

Catechism fees are \$30 per child or \$50 per family. You can:

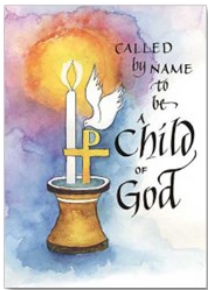

We will be going over music for each Sunday as well as building our repertoire for upcoming church liturgies. If you have any questions please contact Maurise Levesque after mass on

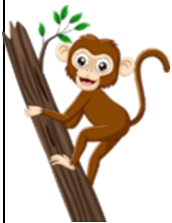
