## Catechism Registration for 2025-2026 for All YEAR Levels has begun!



Formal catechism in our St. Elizabeth of the Trinity Parish Grouping begins for all children who will be six years old before December 31<sup>st</sup> of this year. We use a "Parent Coaching Model" where parents/guardians and children come to catechism and sit at a table together. A Coaching Catechist leads the parents through each session so that the parent is, in fact, the Catechist for the child!

**Catechism sessions for 2025-26 will begin the week of September 8<sup>th</sup>.**

→ Catechism sessions are 75-90 minutes in length and take place once every two weeks. You will accompany your child to each session where you will journey alongside them, as together you grow in faith. (We understand that families lead busy lives. If you are unable to attend with your child, they may be accompanied by another adult, such as a grandparent, an aunt or uncle, or a close family friend.)

Children will be separated into groupings: one grouping for **Years 1, 2 and 3** and another grouping for **Years 4, 5 and 6**. If you have more than one child registered in the same grouping, (for example a child in Year 1 and another in Year 3) you can all attend the same session together!

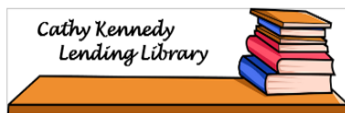
Children in **Year 7** (Confirmation year) will be in their own grouping.

There are two ways to register, and payment is required at time of registration.

Catechism fees are \$30 per child or \$50 per family.

## Exploring Our Faith



T.S. Eliot said in *Four Quartets*, “(Human) kind cannot bear very much reality.” What humans often prefer are highly contrived ways of avoiding the real, the concrete, the physical. We fabricate artificial realities instead, one of which I'm sad to say, is religion itself. So Jesus brought all of our fancy thinking down to earth, to one concrete place of incarnation--this bread and this cup of wine! “Eat it here, and then see it everywhere,” he seems to be saying. If it's too idealized and pretty, if it's somewhere floating around up in the air, it's probably not the Gospel. We come back, again and again, to this marvelous touchstone of orthodoxy, the Eucharist. The first physical incarnation in the body of Jesus is now continued in space and time in ordinary food.

Eucharist is presence encountering presence--mutuality, vulnerability. There is nothing to prove, to protect, or to sell. It feels so empty, naked, and harmless, that all you can do is be present. The Eucharist is telling us that God is the food and all we have to do is provide the hunger. Somehow, we have to make sure that each day we are hungry, that there's room inside of us for another presence. If you are filled with your own opinions, ideas, righteousness, superiority, or sufficiency, you are a world unto yourself and there is no room for “another.” Despite all our attempts to define who is worthy and who is not worthy to receive communion, our only ticket or prerequisite for coming to Eucharist is hunger. And most often sinners are hungrier than “saints.”

When I hand out the bread I love to say to the assembly, “You become what you eat. Come and eat who you are!”
