

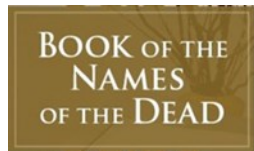

Sign the petition calling for the cancellation of the unjust debts of countries in the Global South.

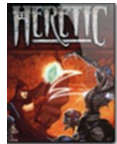
