### New Communion Wine



There have been questions recently regarding the new communion wine and why we are now using white wine. Quick recap. The red wine that we were getting was **California Red** and, as is indicated in the name, came from California. As you are aware, the New Brunswick government made the decision to no longer bring in any alcohol from the United States. Thusly, the diocese did a search of which wines we could use as communion wine and so we have Moscato, which is what we are using now.



Many of us have experienced, or we know someone who has experienced, difficulty breathing, nausea or headaches from things like cigarette smoke and strong cleaning supplies. And it is important for us all to realize that it can be the very same thing for many when it comes to perfumes and some personal care products. Even though these types of smells can be beautiful, they do make some of our parishioners feel quite sick. **Knowing this, we respectfully ask that all parishioners refrain from wearing perfumes and scented products when coming to Mass.**

## **EUCHARIST**

Last Sunday, in our parish grouping of St. Elizabeth of the Trinity, we welcomed 12 children to the Table of the Lord for their very first time. As prepared as they were, like us, these children participated in a mystery that they will never fully understand. None of us do. The imperative from Jesus is to “take and eat, take and drink” even if you we don’t fully grasp the Mystery that has grasped us.

Here’s an understanding of Eucharist (not the only one) by Fr. Richard Rohr.



*T.S. Elliot said in the Four Quartets, “Humankind cannot bear very much reality.” What humans often prefer are highly contrived ways of avoiding the real, the concrete, the physical. We fabricate artificial realities instead, one of which, I’m sad to say, is religion itself. So Jesus brought all of our fancy thinking down to earth, to one concrete place of incarnation—this bread and this cup of wine! “Eat it here, and then see it everywhere,” he seems to be saying. If it’s too idealized and pretty, if it’s somewhere floating around up in the air, it’s probably not the Gospel. We come back again and again, to this marvelous touchstone of orthodoxy, the Eucharist. The first physical incarnation in the body of Jesus is now continued in space and time in ordinary food.*

*Eucharist is presence encountering presence—mutuality, vulnerability. There is nothing to prove, to protect, or to sell. It feels so empty, naked, and harmless, that all you can do is be present. The Eucharist is telling us that God is the food and all we have to do is provide the hunger. Somehow we have to make sure that each day we are hungry, that there’s room inside of us for another presence. If you are filled with your own opinions, ideas, righteousness, superiority, or sufficiency, you are a world unto yourself and there is no room for “another.” Despite all our attempts to define who is worthy and who is not worthy to receive communion, our only ticket or prerequisite for coming to Eucharist is hunger. And most often sinners are hungrier than “saints.”*

*When I hand out the bread I love to say to the assembly, “You become what you eat. Come and eat who you are!”*
